Tasting notes:

Typical aromas of Szürkebarát (Pinot Gris) on the nose, pear, green apple in combination with tropical fruit. Refined, round and creamy texture well supported by the fruit, accompanied by a pleasant bitterness at the finish. Very long wine with an excellent balance between the lovely fruitiness and the serious structure.

Szürkebarát is such a popular variety, that needs no further explanation to the wine loving community. The light, fresh and crisp style has a huge fashion amongst the wine drinkers, but this character, that shows a more serious face of the variety, is fairly popular as well. At the Somló wine region the Szürkebarát is never just an everyday wine. It shares the combination of playfulness with the more serious mineral driven characters, an exciting wine, yet easy to understand.

What do we recommend with it?

Great wine to accompany friendly gatherings, summer BBQ's and parties, but also a perfect partner next to the bath tub at a relaxing night. Chilled at 12-14°C good match to grilled food, roasted meat, grilled vegetables.
